MIN

THE 20-MINUTE RESET

A quick reset keeps your RV peaceful and ready for the road.

- ☐ Clear counters and surfaces
- ☐ Put things back in their homes
- ☐ Empty trash and wipe surfaces
- ☐ Gather items that need a home

K

KITCHEN

- ☐ Keep only what you regularly use and love.
- ☐ Group tools by how you cook.
- ☐ Keep everyday items within easy reach.
- ☐ Use bins/dividers only after measuring the space.
- ☐ Remove duplicate utensils and gadgets.
- ☐ Keep counters as clear as possible.

P

PANTRY

- ☐ Group foods by category.
- ☐ Use shallow or clear containers for staples.
- ☐ Label bins or shelves when helpful.
- ☐ Store heavier items on lower shelves.
- ☐ Check dates and rotate stock.
- ☐ Keep a simple running grocery list.

R

REFRIGERATOR

- ☐ Wipe shelves and drawers regularly.
- ☐ Use small bins to contain loose items.
- ☐ Keep like items together.
- ☐ Keep produce visible and accessible.
- ☐ Create a small use-first area for leftovers.
- ☐ Do not overcrowd - air needs to flow.

B

BATHROOM

- ☐ Keep only daily-use items accessible.
- ☐ Use baskets or bins for small products.
- ☐ Store backups together in one place.
- ☐ Remove expired or unused products.
- ☐ Wipe surfaces and keep them clear.
- ☐ Secure bottles before travel.

BR

BEDROOM

- ☐ Keep surfaces calm and simple.
- ☐ Use under-bed storage intentionally.
- ☐ Limit clothing to what you actually wear.
- ☐ Fold vertically so drawer contents stay visible.
- ☐ Keep a small laundry basket handy.
- ☐ Store linens as complete sets.

TIP

ORGANIZATION TIP

- ☐ **Everything needs a home.** When each item has a place, it is easier to put things away and keep your RV feeling calm instead of constantly reorganizing it.
- ☐ **Before buying another organizer:** decide exactly what will live in it and measure the space first.

LIVING AREA

- ☐ Keep main surfaces clear of daily clutter.
- ☐ Give remotes, chargers, pet gear, and small electronics one home.
- ☐ Use one basket for blankets instead of loose piles.
- ☐ Keep only current reading or projects out.
- ☐ Create a small landing spot for keys and sunglasses.
- ☐ Keep pathways and slide areas completely clear.

C

CRAFT / HOBBY SPACE

- ☐ Keep only current projects accessible.
- ☐ Use clear or clearly labeled bins.
- ☐ Organize supplies by activity.
- ☐ Store frequently used tools within easy reach.
- ☐ Create one portable project kit.
- ☐ Review and purge extra supplies seasonally.

O

OUTDOOR STORAGE

- ☐ Group items by setup, tools, maintenance, and outdoor gear.
- ☐ Use sturdy labeled bins that fit the bay depth.
- ☐ Keep hookup gear closest to access doors.
- ☐ Store heavy items low and balanced side-to-side.
- ☐ Protect stored items from moisture and road dust.
- ☐ Keep emergency and utility equipment easy to reach.

T

TRAVEL-DAY CHECK

- ☐ Clear counters, tables, sinks, floors, and shower.
- ☐ Latch cabinet and refrigerator doors.
- ☐ Pad or secure breakables.
- ☐ Make sure heavy items cannot shift.
- ☐ Secure electronics and loose decor.
- ☐ Keep slides, steps, vents, and exits clear.
- ☐ Close and lock outdoor storage bays.

MAINTENANCE ROUTINE

☐ Daily: clear the main counter	☐ Weekly: reset refrigerator + pantry	☐ Monthly: check expiration dates
☐ Daily: return loose items home	☐ Weekly: empty catch-all baskets	☐ Monthly: check hidden storage
☐ Weekly: add unwanted items to donation bag	☐ Monthly: check enclosed areas for moisture	☐ Seasonally: remove what you never use
